NOW IS THE TIME TO PUT TOGETHER YOUR TEAM TO ENTER IN THE HBA IN-HOUSE LEAGUE, ONE OF THE MOST ENJOYABLE COMPETITIONS IN THE CALENDAR.

THIS IS THE EVENT IN WHICH YOUR TEAM PLAYS THE OTHER TEAMS IN YOUR DIVISION AT HOME OR AWAY - YOU WILL PROBABLY NEED TO PLAY 4 OR 5 MATCHES SPREAD OVER 8 MONTHS.

NO LAVISH HOSPITALITY NECESSARY WHEN AT HOME - JUST TEA/COFFEE AND BISCUITS. THE EMPHASIS IS ON FRIENDLY PLAY AWAY FROM CLUB OR COMPETITION PRESSURES.

The League is divided into 2 Sections - the Restricted Section for those who want to play only the Standard English system of bidding and the Open Section for everybody else.

The more teams who enter, the more enjoyable the competition will be, so please try to get 4 friends together to enter a team - and then persuade your other friends to enter as well (Full or Dual members of HBA).
